Lookout notice against 'absconder' Prajwal; MLA dad booked for rape

H D Revanna seeks anticipatory bail; another woman files complaint against Prajwal

MORE trouble seems to be brewing for Hassan MP Prajwal Revanna and his MLA father H D Revanna in the alleged sex videos case as the Special Investigation Team (SIT) issued a lookout notice against Prajwal while a Hassan court allowed the SIT to invoke rape charges against MLA Revanna, who has moved a special court seeking anticipatory bail. Further, another woman has filed a complaint of sexual harassment against Prajwal.

As Prajwal failed to appear before the investigation officer despite being served a notice, the SIT issued a lookout notice against him on Thursday, terming him an 'absconder'. As per the lookout notice, the law enforcement agencies have been requested to arrest him wherever he is sighted. The notice



has been issued to all immigration points at airports, sea ports and also border checkposts.

Prajwal, who is said to be in Europe, on Wednesday sought a week's time to appear before the SIT through his advocate. It is said Prajwal has booked a return ticket to Bengaluru from Munich in Germany on May 15 and will be landing in the city in the wee hours of May 16. However, the MP is said to have flown to Dubai from Munich on Wednesday. Continuing the probe, the SIT on Thursday recorded the statement of one of

the victims before a magistrate under section 164 of CrPC. The SIT has managed to identify some of the victims. But the investigators are not getting much cooperation from them. It is said that some victims have threatened to commit suicide if they are forced to give any statements. Besides, the investigation agency has also issued a notice to a person, identified as Naveen Gowda from Belur in Hassan, who is accused of distributing the pen drives containing the videos and photographs of the MP with the victims. Poornachandra Tejaswi MG, a supporter of Prajwal Revanna, had filed a complaint against Gowda, who is said to be a close aide of a minister, in

Gowda is alleged to have posted the video on social media and deleted it after the com-

plaint was filed. The SIT officers have found proof against Karthik, the former car driver of Prajwal Revanna, of leaking obscene videos on WhatsApp to Naveen Gowda.

Speaking to reporters in Kalaburagi, Home Minister Dr G Parameshwar confirmed that, so far, two women have lodged sexual harassment complaints. He said Prajwal, through his advocate, requested the SIT to give him more time to appear before it. "As far as my knowledge goes, there is no provision to extend the time. If he fails to appear before SIT, it may initiate steps to arrest him. Already a 'Look Out Notice' has been served against him," he added. The government will not interfere with the investigation being carried out by the SIT. If Revanna fails to appear before SIT on Thursday, the SIT may take steps to arrest him, Parameshwar warned.

She advised the girls to abandon the feminist ideology they have in their heads. "Women's League is the feeder organisation of the IUML that enabled the women to uphold their identity and faith. It pained us a lot when some of these girls called us the Kitchen League," she said, adding that one can see many women who had swum against the current in the 30vear-old history of the organisation.

Noorbina said Islamic feminism is an ideology coined to attract Muslim girls to liberalism. "Those who imbibe the idea will be against the ideology of the IUML," she said. Noorbina expressed the hope that the re-inducted girls will not engage in any activity that promotes liberalism among Muslim girls.

Expressing concern, a candidate said, "I did not receive a new date for the driving test after the earlier one was cancelled abruptly. I don't know when I can take the test. The validity of my learners' license will expire in two months."

Shigella scare in P'thitta after death of 8-year-old girl in Adoor

Pathanamthitta: Pathanamthitta is facing a Shigella scare after an 8-year-old girl from Adoor, who was undergoing treatment at the Kottayam MCH for vomiting and diarrhoea, died on Tuesday. Avantika, a Class III student from Kadambanad, died after her health deteriorated following vomiting and diarrhoea. The health department carried out a cleaning drive after some of the residents in the area complained of vomiting and diarrhoea, the common symptoms of shigellosis. However, the district medical officer said there was no confirmation regarding Shigella.
