

Lookout notice against ‘absconder’ Prajwal; MLA dad booked for rape

H D Revanna seeks anticipatory bail; another woman files complaint against Prajwal

MORE trouble seems to be brewing for Hassan MP Prajwal Revanna and his MLA father H D Revanna in the alleged sex videos case as the Special Investigation Team (SIT) issued a lookout notice against Prajwal while a Hassan court allowed the SIT to invoke rape charges against MLA Revanna, who has moved a special court seeking anticipatory bail. Further, another woman has filed a complaint of sexual harassment against Prajwal.

As Prajwal failed to appear before the investigation officer despite being served a notice, the SIT issued a lookout notice against him on Thursday, terming him an ‘absconder’. As per the lookout notice, the law enforcement agencies have been requested to arrest him wherever he is sighted. The notice



has been issued to all immigration points at airports, sea ports and also border checkpoints.

Prajwal, who is said to be in Europe, on Wednesday sought a week’s time to appear before the SIT through his advocate. It is said Prajwal has booked a return ticket to Bengaluru from Munich in Germany on May 15 and will be landing in the city in the wee hours of May 16. However, the MP is said to have flown to Dubai from Munich on Wednesday. Continuing the probe, the SIT on Thursday recorded the statement of one of

the victims before a magistrate under section 164 of CrPc. The SIT has managed to identify some of the victims. But the investigators are not getting much cooperation from them. It is said that some victims have threatened to commit suicide if they are forced to give any statements. Besides, the investigation agency has also issued a notice to a person, identified as Naveen Gowda from Belur in Hassan, who is accused of distributing the pen drives containing the videos and photographs of the MP with the victims. Poornachandra Tejaswi MG, a supporter of Prajwal Revanna, had filed a complaint against Gowda, who is said to be a close aide of a minister, in the Hassan CEN police station for circulating the videos on April 23.

Gowda is alleged to have posted the video on social media and deleted it after the com-

plaint was filed. The SIT officers have found proof against Karthik, the former car driver of Prajwal Revanna, of leaking obscene videos on WhatsApp to Naveen Gowda.

Speaking to reporters in Kalaburagi, Home Minister Dr G Parameshwar confirmed that, so far, two women have lodged sexual harassment complaints. He said Prajwal, through his advocate, requested the SIT to give him more time to appear before it. “As far as my knowledge goes, there is no provision to extend the time. If he fails to appear before SIT, it may initiate steps to arrest him. Already a ‘Look Out Notice’ has been served against him,” he added. The government will not interfere with the investigation being carried out by the SIT. If Revanna fails to appear before SIT on Thursday, the SIT may take steps to arrest him, Parameshwar warned.

You did lots of damage to IUML, says Women’s League leader to Haritha girls

MUSLIM Women’s League national general secretary Noorbina Rashid has expressed some reservations over the re-induction of the former leaders of Haritha, who had raised a banner of revolt against their parent organisation. In a Facebook post on Thursday, she also expressed the hope that the girls will not be the propagators of Islamic feminism, which is against the basic ideology of the party.

It may be recalled that the IUML leadership had withdrawn disciplinary action against the girls and had elevated them to the national leadership of the Muslim Youth League. The former Haritha leaders, including Fatima Thahliya and Najma Thabsheera, had filed a case against MSF state president P K Navas for insulting womanhood. Haritha is the girl’s wing of the MSF functioning on the

campuses. In the post, Noorbina said the utterances of these girls had brought immense damage to the party. “IUML workers were portrayed as anti-

woman and those who nurture obsolete ideology. They (former Haritha leaders) still believe that all those were part of their struggle. They should think of lakhs of party workers whose heads were lowered in shame when the media framed headlines like Taliban League,” she said.

Noorbina said the girls were re-inducted into the party considering the letter they gave to the leadership and after the withdrawal of the case they

filed. “The party leaders asked you to refrain from such things like a father advising children. You had left the IUML to the mercy of the media and the communists, who were preying on the party,” Noorbina said.

She advised the girls to abandon the feminist ideology they have in their heads. “Women’s League is the feeder organisation of the IUML that enabled the women to uphold their identity and faith. It pained us a lot when some of these girls called us the Kitchen League,” she said, adding that one can see many women who had swum against the current in the 30-year-old history of the organisation.

Noorbina said Islamic feminism is an ideology coined to attract Muslim girls to liberalism. “Those who imbibed the idea will be against the ideology of the IUML,” she said. Noorbina expressed the hope that the re-inducted girls will not engage in any activity that promotes liberalism among Muslim girls.

Pathanamthitta: Pathanamthitta is facing a Shigella scare after an 8-year-old girl from Adoor, who was undergoing treatment at the Kottayam Medical College Hospital for vomiting and diarrhoea, passed away on Tuesday. Avantika, a Class III student from Kadambanad village, died on April 30 after her health deteriorated following vomiting and diarrhoea. The health department carried out a cleaning drive after some of the residents in the area complained of vomiting and diarrhoea, the common symptoms of shigellosis. However, the district medical officer said there was no confirmation regarding Shigella.

THE statement by Transport Minister K B Ganesh Kumar, suggesting that a mafia in Malappuram is behind the protests against driving test revamps, has drawn criticism from various quarters. Responding to the protests on Thursday, Ganesh said the government would not tolerate such mafia-led protests. Malappuram experienced protests at driving test centres on the day, with driv-



ing school owners blocking motor vehicle officers from entering the driving test grounds.

The minister's statement was perceived by protestors as an attack on Malappuram district. They demanded that the minister retract his statement and issue an apology. "The minister seems to get angry whenever Malappuram is mentioned. His statement is offensive to the district. He should retract it," said Abdul Gafoor, CITU Malappuram district secretary.
