announced Ms. Kirti Bharti, a regional winner of their #CelebrateHERos campaign.





#CelebrateHERoes is a national campaign conceptualized and run jointly by HDFC Bank and MasterCard to identify, recognize and reward ordinary people in the society who were undertaking extraordinary efforts towards woman empowerment #CelebrateHERoes is a people-led campaign wherein customers, employees,

Based in Jodhpur, Rajasthan, Ms. Bharti is a Rehabilitation Psychologist and the founder of Saarthi Trust, a not-for-profit organisation. Over the past 9 years, she has stopped 900 and annulled 31 child marriages, in addition to rehabilitating over 6,000 children and 5,500 women all over Rajasthan.

The campaign received about 200 valid entries which were evaluated by a jury comprising HDFC Bank and MasterCard officials along with an NGO partner Concern India on the parameters of Scale, Impact, and Selflessness of their efforts. The jury has selected a national winner and 7 regional winners.

At an event organized in Jaipur, chief guest Mr. V. Chakrapani, Country Head – Internal Audit and Chief of Internal Vigilance, gave a reward of Rs. 8 lakh To Ms. Kirti Bharti, in the presence of Ms. Smita Bhagat, Branch Banking Head, HDFC Bank, and other senior HDFC Bank officials.

Total income for the year ended March 31, 2016, was INR 709.73 billion (Rs 70973.2 crore).
