HDFC Bank installs four oxygen plants in Uttar Pradesh

Oxygen Plant each set up in Gorakhpur, Varanasi, Bhadohi & Lucknow

Lucknow, August 18th, 2021: HDFC Bank today announced to install four oxygen plants in Gorakhpur, Varanasi, Bhadohi and Lucknow to strengthen the healthcare infrastructure in Uttar Pradesh under its flagship CSR programme Parivartan.
